TAP's Juan Rodrigo Rodriguez Memorial Scholarship Fund was developed to honor the memory of Lance Cpl. Juan Rodrigo Rodriguez, who was killed in action January 13, 2005 in Iraq. Juan was a 23-year-old Marine reservist assigned to Charlie Company, 1 st Battalion, 23rd Marines, based in Corpus Christi. After completing his basic training for the Marines in 2001, Juan went to work for L. Bufalo Pawn in Laredo. Bob Simpson, owner of L. Bufalo Pawn and long time member of TAP, remembers Juan as his hardest working, least complaining, and a most trustworthy employee. According to Mr. Simpson, when Juan was activated to serve his country, he did so proudly and with honor.
